

RMI, Your Rights and Obligations

The **RMI** : (minimum revenue benefit): is a state benefit and a step towards intergration.

It is a benefit guaranteeing you a **minimum income**.

A **referent** and an **integration contract** to aid your social or professional integration.

A minimum income for you and your family

As soon as your application for RMI is completed (application form filled and all necessary documents provided), your instructor sends it to the Social Security Office of Lyon or Villefranche sur Saône (CAF) or to the Farm Workers Social Security Office (MSA).

These organizations will pay you a Minimum Revenue benefit every month on behalf of the local authority (département) once your personal situation has been examined.

Your integration is our priority

In the coming month, the president of the local council will name a referent for you or a member of your family on the basis of a document called a pre-designation file. It is filled at the same time as your RMI application form by you and your instructor.

Your referent will invite you to an **appointment** by mail.

His role is :

- to construct **with you a stage by stage project for social or professional intregation** and to accompany you in its realisation by regular interviews,
- **to establish your integration contract with you** (obligatory after recieving RMI benefit for more than 3 months). He puts in writing concrete plans with deadlines which should help you to gain access to a suitable professional activity or to improve your daily life. It is signed by the beneficiary and the president of the local council for a period lasting between 3 to 12 months (renewable).

The RMI guarantees you rights

The right to medical cover

- ▶ Access to universal medical cover (CMU).
- ▶ Access to complementary medical cover.

The right to housing aid

- ▶ Full personalised aid for housing (APL).
- ▶ Exemption from council tax and a reduction in telephone bill (fixed line only).

The right to integration activities

- ▶ Social support services: access to health care, housing, legal aid ...
- ▶ Guidance.
- ▶ Aided employment: RMA (Minimum Revenue for Activity), CA (Futur Improvement Contract), CAE (Access to Employment Contract).
- ▶ Aid in the creation or resumption of activity.
- ▶ Aid funds for insertion.
- ▶ Aid for travel expenses: reduced tariffs (TCL et SNCF).

It also imposes some obligations

Being the actor of your integration

- ▶ You must attend all appointments made with your referent.
- ▶ You must take the necessary steps to realise your plan.

To fulfill administrative procedures

- ▶ To send your quarterly revenue declaration form (DTR) to your social security office (CAF or MSA).
- ▶ To inform your social security office of all changes in your situation (change of address, change of the number of people in your household).

Warning

The non-respect of one of your obligations can lead to the suspension of your receipt of RMI benefit on the decision of the president of the local commission for integration or the president of the local council.

Please bring the following documents with you :

1 • Right of Stay

- ▶ Your Identity card or the proof of your right of stay if you are a foreigner.
- ▶ The proof of right of stay of your husband/wife or live-in partner.
- ▶ The proof of right of stay of your children if they are over 18 years of age.
- ▶ Any official document proving that you are recognized as a refugee.
An OFPRA or “Comission de Recours des Réfugiés” decision (CRR).

2 • Family status

- ▶ An official family record book or that of your live-in partner.
If unavailable, any other document proving the civil status of your children.

3 • Resources

- ▶ The ASSEDIC certificate.
- ▶ An official slip showing bank account details from your bank (RIB) or Post Office (RIP).

4 • Health

- ▶ Social Security card or your C.M.U. (Universal Medical Cover) certificate.

5 • Housing

- ▶ A proof of address.
