The platform was designed within the SAFE framework, **foSter cooperAtion For improving access to protEction**, a three-year project (2021-2023), co-funded by the European Union, and implemented by seven partners: **Forum réfugiés**, **Federation of Protestant Mutual Aid (FEP)**, **Italian Federation of Protestant Churches (FCEI)**; **Italian and French Red Cross**; **Mediterranean Universities Union (UNIMED)**; **Oxfam Italy**.

The project's main goal is to facilitate global **exchanges** and **cooperation** on complementary pathways and private sponsorship schemes (PSS). Any actor involved or interested in safe legal pathways can **collaborate** on the three features of the platform: the resources, the interactive map, and the forum - and therefore participate in creating a community to share good practices and experiences amongst peers!



**Resources:** SAFE partners collaborated to create a **collection of resources** (videos, reports, articles, factsheets, etc) for the website. You too, can collaborate by uploading your resources, via the online form! This will help consolidate the website library and thus, increase knowledge sharing on complementary pathways and PSS.

**Interactive map:** the interactive map displays (for now!) actors involved in legal protection pathways in France and Italy. With the **online form**, you can add any organization - including yourself - operating in Europe and beyond, to increase their **visibility** in the complementary pathways and PSS community.
